

The Travel Game

You need: Game board, four counters or markers, answer sheet, list of card answers, playing cards and dice with specific numbers relevant to the game.

This is a game for four players. It can be prepared by the teacher or students can make their own game once they understand how the game is played. The operation chosen for practice can be multiplication, addition or subtraction. Blank dice enable you to tailor the game to suit specific student needs. The additional playing cards can be used to vary the questions so that they are not straight computation, can be used to practice operations such as division or can be used for quick word problems.

Rules of the game:

1. Each player begins with their marker on the starting space.
2. The player to the left of the starting player holds the answer sheet and checks the answer.
3. To move you must throw the two dice and multiply (if this is the chosen operation) to give the correct answer. The player to the left checks the answer sheet. For incorrect answers, move back one space (this can be negotiated with the group)
4. When you land on 'Select a Card', take a card from the pile and answer the question. If you are correct, you may move ahead one space. Return the card to the bottom of the pile.
5. When your turn is finished hand the dice to the next person. The person with the answer sheet then hands it to you.
6. The first player to land on 'Finish' is the winner.
